

General Information

Montego Bay is located in the Caribbean Sea, 630 km from the Central American subcontinent, 150km south of Cuba and 180 km west of the Hispaniola Island which situates Haiti and the Dominican Republic.

Total Area: 240 km long and a maximum of 80 km wide.

Total Population: 110.115 citizens.

Currency: Jamaican Dollar **Official Language:** English

Electricity: 110V voltage –50Hz Frequency. Type AB electric outlets

Geography: The island of Jamaica consists of mountainous terrain surrounded by a small strip of coastal plain. For this reason, Kingston and Montego Bay cities are located by the coast. Its lowest point is the Caribbean Sea at 0 meters; the highest point is Blue Mountain 2.256 meters.

Seasons and Climate: Jamaica features a dry season from November to April as well as rainy season from May to October. Hurricane season occurs from June to November.

Touristic Attractions:

Do not miss Montego Bay beaches such as: Doctor's Cave, Ocho Rios, and Negril. Along with the exotic Rockland bird watching, Ipswich caves, and Appleton rum factory, you can also snorkel in Negril, go rafting in Rio Grande, visit the Dunny River cascades, and visit Bob Marley's grave.

What to do in Jamaica?

Considerations:

Kingston is an airport alternative to Montego Bay. For passengers visiting the Ochos Rios zone, the highway connecting the capital with the zone is well built – approximately an hour and a half of travel.
